Fascination of Plants Day May 18th 2013



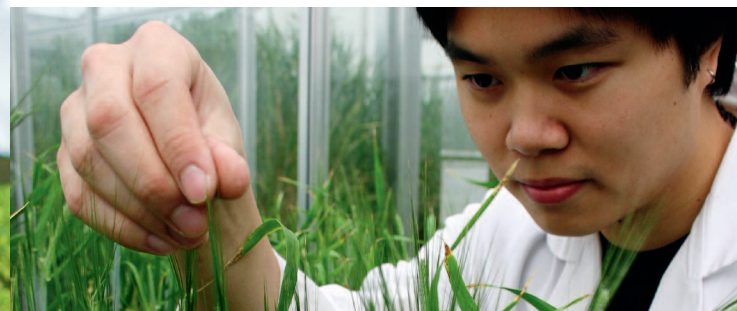
